Since its origin on October 12, 1894, when 20 individuals established the Benevolent & Protective Order of the Elks in Waterloo, the Waterloo Elks Lodge has h ad a long and prestigious history.

Through the years, it has played an extremely active role in both the community and Elkdom. The Lodge constructed its present facility in 1924. This stately building, located in downtown Waterloo, was designed to reflect the character of the Old Italian Villas. Extensive use of marble, tile, Bedford brick, black walnut and stained glass enhance the architectural décor which is still preserved today.

The 1950's and 1960's were major years of growth where the organization became 4,000 Members strong. Our organization was the epicenter of socializing and service to the

Waterloo and Cedar Falls area.

On January 2, 2008, the Waterloo Elks Lodge underwent renovations to preserve its grand and magnificent architecture and to make the Lodge operate more efficiently. A portion of the renovations went towards remodeling various rooms around the building; including updating the worn décor.

In November 2008, the renovations were complete and a fully-restored and beautiful building emerged. Even today, many of the Members and the Elks staff encourage people to come and admire the magnificent building.

This superbly kept building, with its excellent facilities, handles the many activities of a very active Lodge with a constantly growing Membership. Follow them on Facebook
