On Wednesday, May 13 Governor Reynolds issued a proclamation which begins the process of reopening. Not all business have been cleared to open, many are making the choice to remain closed for the safety of their staff and customers, and those who are opening will be making several changes to keep you and their staff safe. Please visit our website for a complete list of businesses (updated daily).

The proclamation is effective 5:00AM May 15, 2020 through 11:59PM May 27, 2020.

Restaurants:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- Group sizes are limited to no more than six (6) people
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Fitness Centers:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- All equipment will be spaced at least six (6) feet apart
- Classes will be limited to ten (10) or fewer people
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Retail:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Salons & Barber Shops:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- By appointment only
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Tattoo Shops:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- By appointment only
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Libraries:

- Limited to 50% of its normal operating capacity
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Social and Fraternal Clubs:

- No more than ten (10) people allowed at a time
- They will be implementing reasonable measures to ensure social distancing and increased hygiene practices

Also opening, but not in Downtown Waterloo: Malls, Medical Spas, Tanning Facilities, Massage Therapy establishments, Campgrounds, Race Tracks, and Drive-in Theaters.

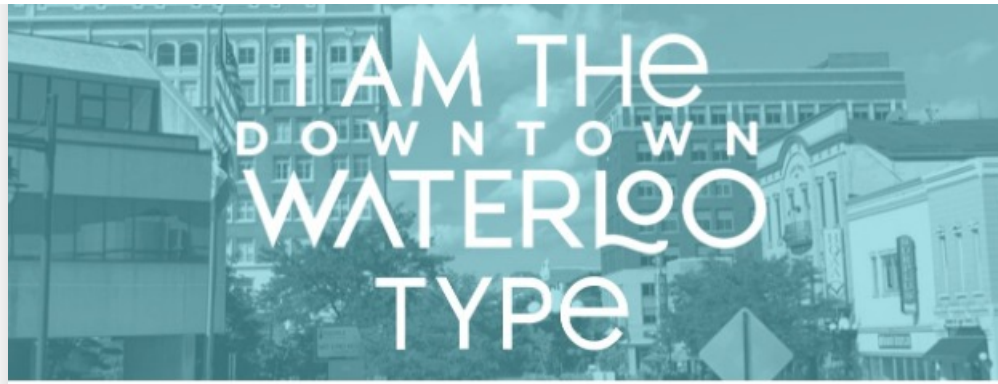
The proclamation **extended** the closure of the following types of businesses:

- Bars
- Theaters
- Casinos and gaming facilities
- Senior citizen centers and adult daycare facilities
- Amusements (bingo halls, bowling alleys, pool halls, arcades, and amusement parks)
- Museums, aquariums, and zoos
- Skating rinks and skate parks
- Playgrounds
- Swimming pools
- Door-t-door sales

Mass gatherings continue to be limited to ten (10) people or less. We are carefully watching the situation and guidance to make decisions about summer events. We will announce any additional cancellations or postponements as they come available.

*Note: Spiritual and religious gatherings are no longer prohibited by this extension.
