In 2021, Main Street Waterloo will celebrate our 25th year as an organization working to revitalize our city center, recruit new businesses, support downtown businesses and engage the community.


We began as three organizations who shared a dream of revitalizing Downtown Waterloo and came together to become an accredited Main Street community in 1996.
