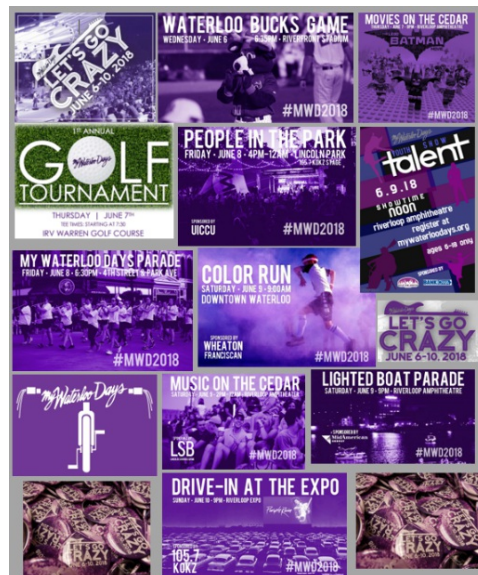
We will take a break and enjoy the MWD parade from 6:30-7:30.

Downtown Spotlight

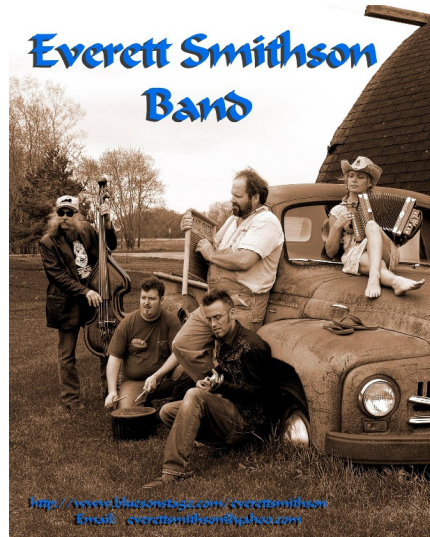
